Visit Edmonton's premier pedestrian streets: the 4th Street Promenade, Rice Howard Way, or venture to Old Strathcona or 124th Street. Edmonton's Arts District hosts the world-class Art Gallery of Alberta, the Winspear Centre concert hall, The Citadel Theatre, the Stanley A. Milner Library, and the landmark City Hall. Downtown Pedways

The indoor pedway system consists of underground and above ground walkways connecting various downtown buildings and malls. The pedways provide shoppers, visitors, and workers with year-round comfort and convenience and has indoor access to 3 LRT stations.

Opening times

Pedway connections are Indoor Links between buildings. Unless otherwise stated, pedway connections are generally open between these times:

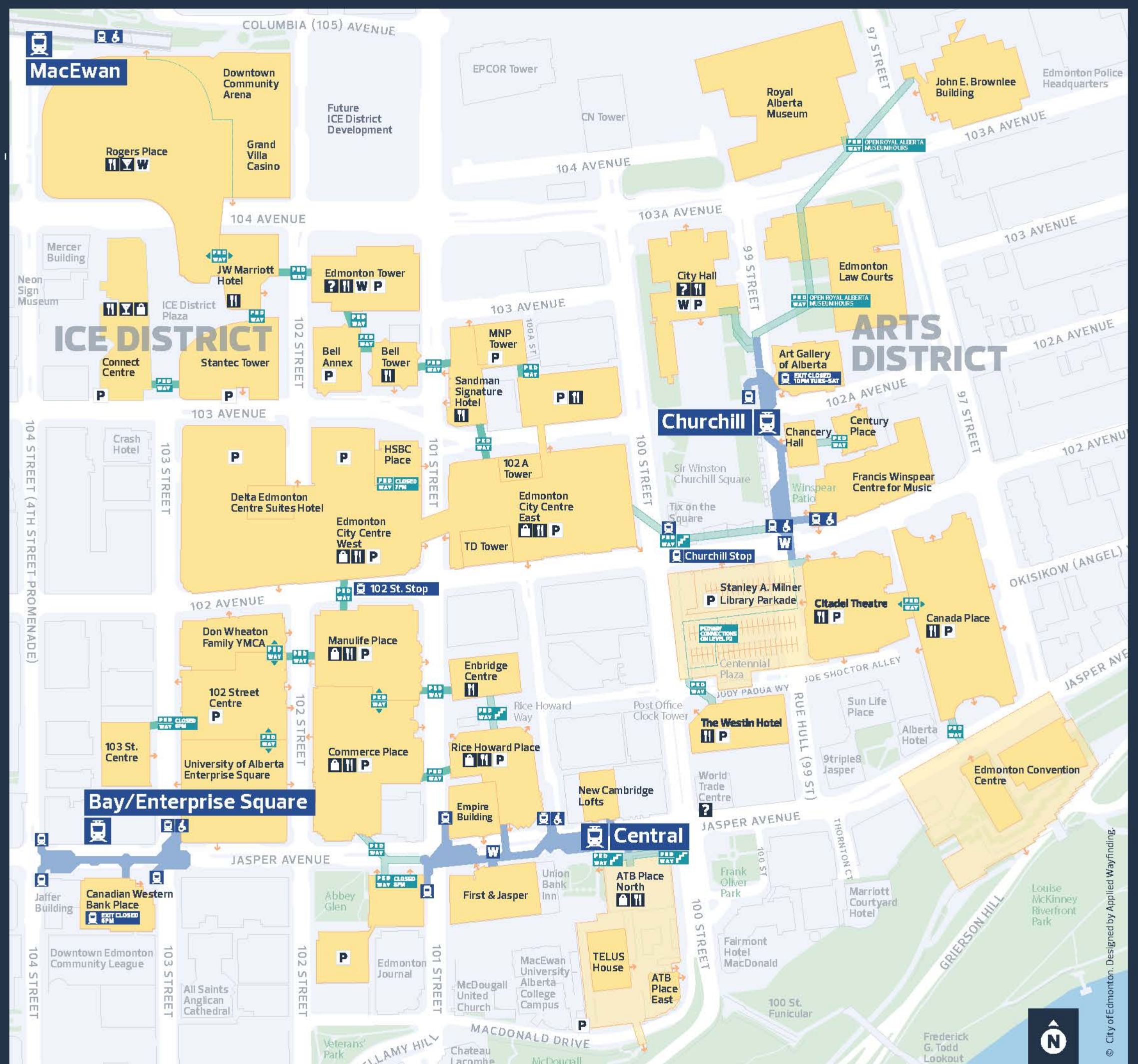
- 6am-11pm Monday to Saturday
