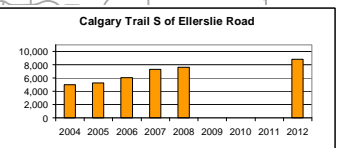
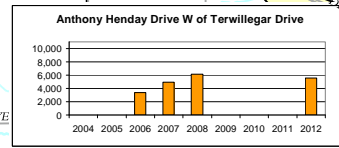
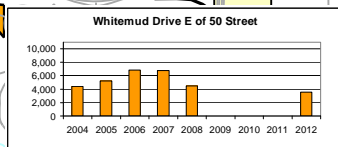
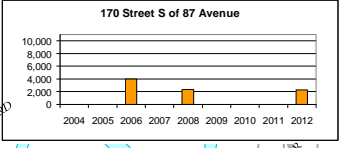
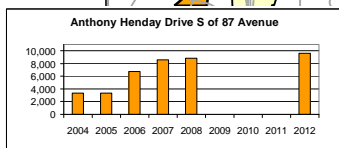
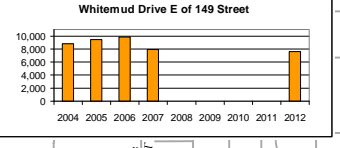
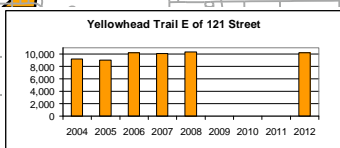
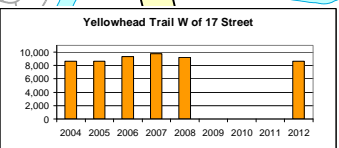
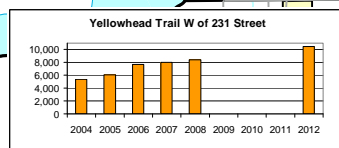
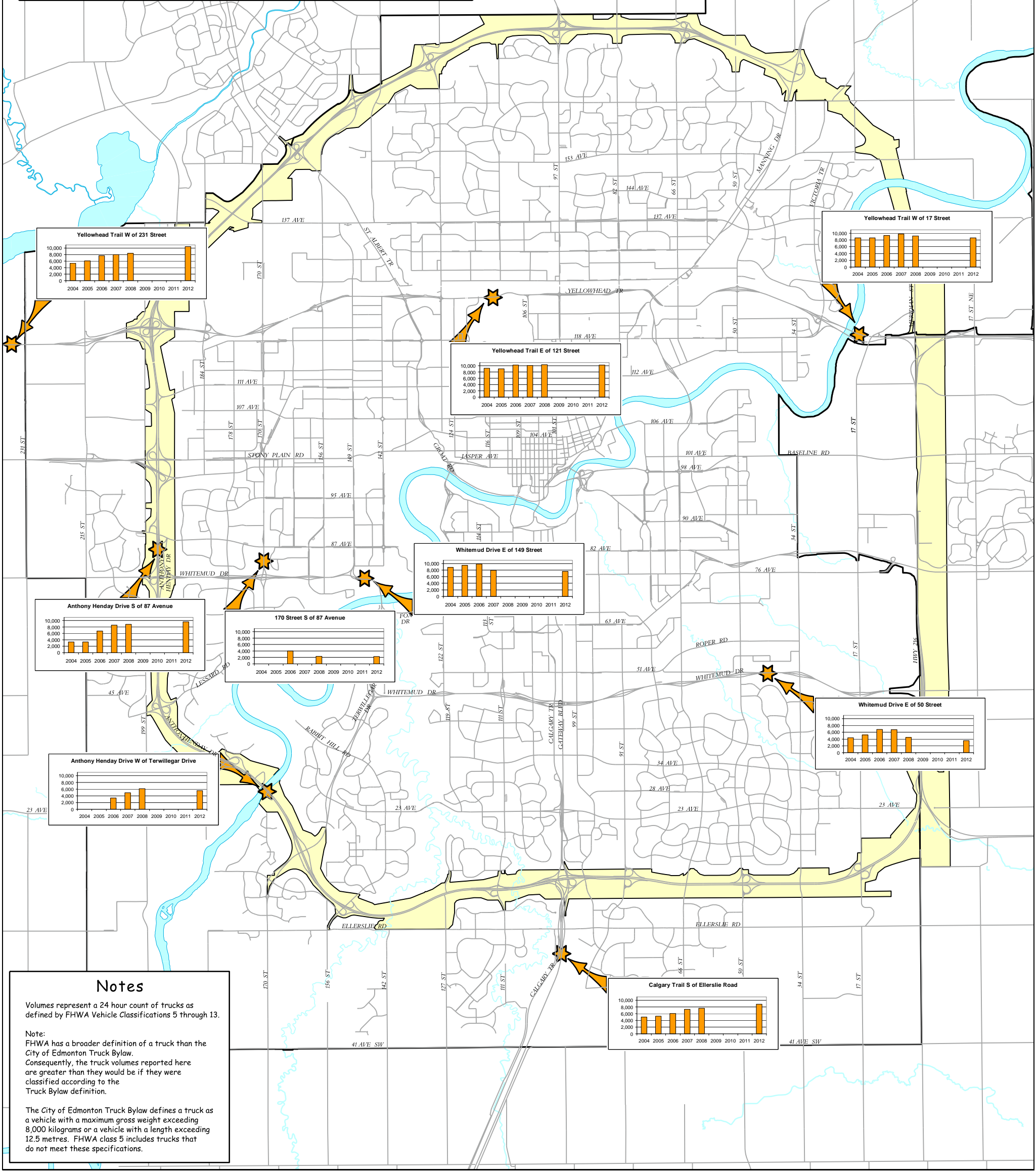
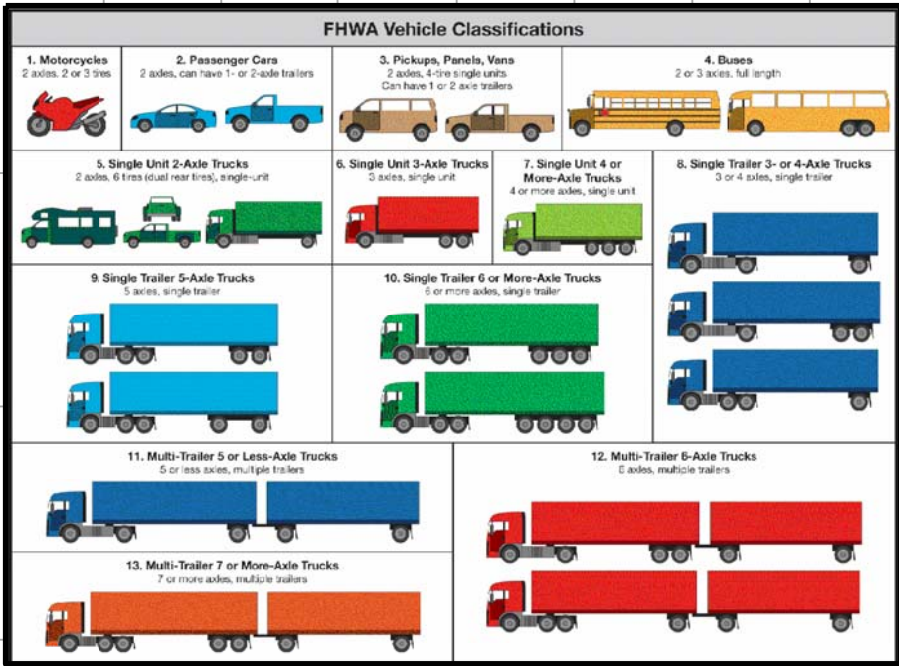


2004 - 2012 Two-Way 24-Hour Truck Volumes



Notes

Volumes represent a 24 hour count of trucks as defined by FHWA Vehicle Classifications 5 through 13.

Note:
FHWA has a broader definition of a truck than the City of Edmonton Truck Bylaw. Consequently, the truck volumes reported here are greater than they would be if they were classified according to the Truck Bylaw definition.

The City of Edmonton Truck Bylaw defines a truck as a vehicle with a maximum gross weight exceeding 8,000 kilograms or a vehicle with a length exceeding 12.5 metres. FHWA class 5 includes trucks that do not meet these specifications.
