

GUARDIAN ROAD/LEWIS ESTATES BOULEVARD WIDENING GRANTHAM DRIVE TO POTTER GREENS DRIVE

BACKGROUND

In order to meet growing demand in the Grange and Lewis Estates neighborhoods, the City of Edmonton is preparing a concept plan for the widening of Guardian Road/Lewis Estates Boulevard from Grantham Drive to Potter Greens Drive, with construction work expected to begin in 2013.

HIGHLIGHTS

- Approximately 1.0 km of roadway widening to a 4 lane urban, divided standard with turning lanes.
- No additional property required, and all existing accesses and intersections will be maintained.
- Transitions to existing 2 lane road east of Grantham Drive and north of Potter Greens Drive.
- Improvements to the intersection of Whitemud Drive and Guardian Road/Lewis Estates Boulevard.
- Construction of missing sidewalk and trail connections along Guardian Road.
- Signalization of the widened Lewis Estates Boulevard/Potter Greens Drive intersection.
- Installation of pedestrian signals at the intersection of Guardian Road/Grantham Drive.
- Relocation and consolidation of bus stops along the corridor.

WHAT ARE THE NEXT STEPS?

- Concept plans will be finalized during Summer 2012, with preliminary design scheduled to begin this fall
- A second open house will be held in Fall 2012 to unveil the completed recommended design
- Construction is expected to begin in 2013
