

50 Street Widening and Railway Grade Separation

Stage one of the 50 Street Widening and Railway Grade Separation project is nearly complete. Traffic is expected to be rerouted onto the northbound overpass **starting in mid-September**. This opening will accommodate two northbound lanes and two southbound lanes. Please watch for, and obey, new signage. With traffic shifted onto the new overpass, stage two will begin with construction of the southbound overpass starting this fall.

Pedestrian access will remain on the west side of 50 Street and the pedestrian crossing signal arms at the rail tracks will stay in operation. Once both overpasses are completed, a new shared pathway will be built on the east side of the northbound overpass, connecting to the existing shared pathway and aligning with the planned future path along 50 Street, south of the Sherwood Park Freeway.

Additionally, a sidewalk will be added on the west side of the southbound overpass.
