

# Dear Neighbour

The City of Edmonton is proposing to provide City-owned land along 128 Avenue, east of 130 Street, to Veterans' House Canada, a non-profit organization dedicated to providing permanent, affordable, and supportive housing to homeless veterans in Canada.

A proposal to rezone a portion of the land (pictured in red) to RA7 was approved by City Council on November 20, 2023. The remaining portion (in green) was rezoned to Public Parks zone (AP) and will remain open space.

A proposal to sell the RA7 development site to Veterans' House Canada for \$1 will now go to Executive Committee for consideration. The report is scheduled for December 6, 2023. If the land sale is approved, Veterans' House Canada is committed to meeting with community members and gathering input on how it can best integrate into your neighbourhood. It is proposing to build a 40 unit, 3-storey building that would provide long-term rental housing as well as on-site support, including counseling and peer mentoring programs.
