## Surveys

- + An online survey was available to the public from February 7 to March 4, 2022, asking residents to help us **CREATE** a Vision and Guiding Principles for Meyokumin's Neighbourhood & Alley Renewal. We also asked people to **REFINE** our understanding of their lived experience in Meyokumin by identifying opportunities to improve or enhance the neighbourhood.
