The Dunluce Neighbourhood and Alley Renewal Project Team organized a number of opportunities during the **Exploring Options and Tradeoffs** stage. These opportunities were available for the public to share their thoughts on the most important considerations when looking at the design options presented. This input will help the Project Team **REFINE** the options into a draft design.



Survey (online)

An online survey was available for the public to complete from April 25 to May 28, 2023. The survey asked participants to review options and tradeoffs, provide their level of comfort with the options and leave feedback on the designs. It also asked respondents to confirm that the Vision and Guiding Principles reflected what is important to them as a Dunluce resident or user.

Public Engagement Event (in-person)

An in-person public engagement event was held on May 11, 2023 at St. Lucy School to share design options and tradeoffs for walking, rolling, biking, driving and open spaces in Dunluce. The public had the opportunity to ask questions and provide feedback.

We asked residents to visit the project web page to access information about the project and the engagement activities.
