Community Conversations

- + The Gariepy Community Committee, made up of 12 community members, met in March 2023. This group provided feedback to guide the engagement opportunities
- + 26 additional emails and phone calls from community members, received by the Project Manager, were also included along with the overall feedback
- + Conversations were also held with other community groups including the commercial area and school

How We Communicated

- + 1 road sign
- + 4 A-frame signs
- + 26 yard signs
- + 1 drop-off box, including information about engagement opportunities
- + 122 emails to list subscribers and local stakeholders
- + 1,144 postcards delivered
- + 834 letters delivered to Gariepy residents and property owners
- + 771 page views on the the project web page
