

Kinnaird Bridge Rehabilitation

The City of Edmonton will be rehabilitating Kinnaird Bridge on 82 Street between 111 Avenue and 112 Avenue. This work will require various lane closures and detours throughout the project area. Traffic will continue to flow north and southbound with turning lanes and pedestrian access will be maintained. One side of the bridge will be closed at a time with both directions of traffic routed to one side, allowing for one lane in each direction. **The rehabilitation will begin in late April or early May (weather permitting) and is anticipated to be complete in fall 2023.**

Scope of Work

- Bridge deck, sidewalk and barrier repairs and upgrades
- Regrading of the underneath bridge deck and strengthening piers
- Painting bottom of piers and sidewalk supports
- Landscaping: tree and shrub restoration and soil clean-up

Access

During the construction period, detours will be maintained to divert non-residential traffic. A lane in each direction will remain open for residential traffic only. Pedestrian access will be maintained whenever possible. 112 Avenue to Stadium Road is a suggested alternative route for those who typically utilize this bridge. Latta Bridge on Jasper Avenue between 90 Street and 91 Street is being replaced and will remain closed until construction is completed. Both bridges are anticipated to reopen in the fall of 2023.
