MacKinnon Ravine Pedestrian Bridge Replacement - Tree Removals

Planning for replacing the MacKinnon Ravine Pedestrian Bridge is underway with construction anticipated to begin in the summer of 2023. The MacKinnon Ravine Pedestrian Bridge is located between Stony Plain Road and Summit Drive. It connects the communities of Grovener and Crestwood, providing an easily accessible connection for those who walk, cycle and roll. Additional information regarding construction impacts will be provided closer to the start date.

Tree removals are required as part of this project. The tree removals are anticipated to begin in early or mid-April (weather permitting). The City of Edmonton project team has worked closely to minimize the number of trees removed and to ensure that the construction work does not compromise the integrity of the retained trees and vegetation within the boundary of this project.

City-owned trees are a highly valued asset and are only removed when all other preservation options are unsuitable. As part of the Urban Forest Management Plan, the City will plant new trees and shrubs in the project area once construction is complete.

This work is expected to take two to five days to complete.
