The City of Edmonton is offering a rare opportunity for residential infill development in the mature neighbhourhood of Pleasantview. This 9,561 sq.ft. site is zoned **RS – Small Scale Residential** and is an excellent opportunity for a netzero semi-detached or row-housing development with the potential for secondary suites (basement and/or garden suites) due to its ample building pocket and 200 amp power service. The site is near to seven schools (within 1km or less), a newly developed dog park directly to the north, and major retail establishments such as Southgate Centre, and Lendrum Centre. It also has great access to the University of Alberta, Saville Community Sports Centre, Calgary Trail and Downtown Edmonton.

The City's *Neighbourhood Renewal Program* is currently undertaking work in *Pleasantview* to beautify and enhance the neighbourhood.
