A survey was available online for the public to submit feedback on the draft Vision and Guiding Principles from January to March 2020. Feedback collected will be used to help finalize the Vision and Guiding Principles for Pleasantview's renewal.

Community engagements

The project team invited residents to stop by and talk about biking in Pleasantview at Mount Pleasant School and Holy Spirit Lutheran Church on February 8 and 11, 2020.

The team also popped up at two neighbourhood locations on March 7, 2020 to talk with residents about opportunities for driving and traffic.

79 total attendees

Ideas and opportunities for biking, driving and traffic, playing and parks, and walking were also collected online and by the door hanger question cards that Pleasantview residents received at their homes.

123 online responses

44 question cards received

All input received to date will be used to begin the Exploring Options and Trade-offs phase of Pleasantview's neighbourhood renewal.
