

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT made between William Humberstone of Edmonton, Coal Miner, and The Town of Edmonton:

The said Humberstone agrees;--

1. To supply and keep supplied, to the Town at the Town Fire Hall, all the coal which may be required by the Town from this date until the 31st December next, placing the same in the usual receptacles provided by the Town therefor.

2. The said coal is to be good and proper coal, suitable for burning in ordinary stoves, and in the Town Fire Engines, and is to be of at least as good quality as that hitherto supplied by Samuel Moran to the Town.

The Town agrees to pay the said Humberstone at the rate of \$2.25 per ton for each ton of coal delivered; payments to be made monthly at the end of each month, except that the amount of the first month's account is to be retained until the termination of this contract, as a guarantee of the due fulfilment thereof on the part of the said Humberstone.

Section 37 of By-Law No. 41 intituled "A By-Law to regulate the proceedings in the Council of the Town of Edmonton and the Committee thereof", is hereby incorporated in this Agreement.

This Agreement may be determined at any time by the Town on one month's notice.

This Agreement is subject to the approval of the Chairman of the Standing Committee on Fire, Water and Light.
