B.2. Procedures for Public Speakers

Based on input from the OCC the use of panels for speakers was discussed. Placing speakers in panels is an efficient way to manage the meeting agenda, as the 5 minute question limit applies to the entire panel - not individual speakers.

B.3. Proposed Timeline to Transition to Public Meetings

P. Spearey proposed the following timeline to accommodate the transition to fully public meetings:

October 5

- Website, etc., to be updated with information regarding public processes
- Website to include EDC submission(s) for public review (ie for the October 19 meeting)
- Committee deliberates 'in public' - using a suitable method
- Committee would allow public speaker(s) if requested (though this is very unlikely)

October 19

- Committee fully operating in public (public speakers, public deliberation)
