

FLOOD VICTIMS

BACK IN HOMES

Trouble Being Experienced in Gallagher's Flats Owing to Lack of Water

Yesterday being a holiday, no additions were made to the flood relief subscription lists around the city, but quite a large quantity of clothing was handed in to the central depot in the Chisholm Block.

W. Davidson, secretary of the Welfare Board, says he expects that by Tuesday next all the families who were flooded out, and whose shacks and houses were washed away, will have returned, but they are confronting a difficult situation owing to the lack of water. The city water mains are not extended to the district, and the two wells used for a public supply caved in as a result of the flood, with the consequence that the work of cleaning the houses is a very slow process.

A health inspector will visit the flooded houses today and report as to their fitness for occupancy.
